

Searching Archives and Public Records of Arizona

What Records Are Available from the Arizona History and Archives Division?

There are quite a few different types of records available through the Arizon History and Archives Division. Among these are: territorial prison records (photos, complete physical descriptions and relatives), miscellaneous books containing land records proof of labor, plat maps, court documents, and some marriage records, brand indexes and books, assessment rolls, coroner or Justice Court records,

Great Registers (contain personal information on those who registered to vote), Superior Court records include pre WWII marriage licenses, wills, probate cases, and civil and criminal cases, birth and death records (births over 75 years old, deaths mor than 50 years old), photographs, etc. Except for the birth and death records, the search will yield source information such as name, source, Call Number, page, dates, and, sometime, the city. The staff of the Arizona History and Archives Division will make photocopies at \$.25 per page; however, I do not know how much they charge to mail these copies. Birth and death records are available online and you may see the digital copies.


- Enter **Surname** and any other search term(s) you want.

Accessing the Arizona Historical Photograph Collection

• Go <u>http://photos.lib.az.us/</u> to search the Historical Photograph Collection.



- Enter the search term you desire. This can be a last name.
- Click on Submit Query or press the <enter> key and the Search Results window will open.

- The Search Results will show a thumbnail of the photo and give some information on the photo.
- You may order a photographic print of the image for \$15 to cover the cost of a negative. This charge does not apply to digital prints.
- **NOTE**: These images are copyrighted and they have a watermark saying something like Property f the Arizona State Archives. There are two "G's" that apply to copyrighted images, but should apply to any images you find on the Internet, I think. These "G's" are GET permission to use it which means asking them and telling them how you are going to use it and GIVE credit which is tell where you got the image.

• Go to http://genealogy.az.gov/ to search the Arizona birth and death records.
