Using the West Virginia Vital Research Records Search

What is the West Virginia Vital Research Records Search?

Through a collaborative effort between the West Virginia State Archives and the Genealogical Society of Utah (GSU), selected West Virginia county birth, death and marriage records, and statewide death records to place online via the West Virginia Archives and History Web site in a viewable, downloadable and searchable format. Births were first reported in the counties in Virginia/West Virginia in 1853, but marriages were reported from the county's formation. In 1917, the West Virginia Department of Health Vital Registration office began collecting the county reports of births and deaths and they issued official state certificates. In some cases, you will find birth records with dates earlier than 1853. These are delayed records accepted by the clerks or are errors. A group of 1920 death records (#4501-5000) are not available since the certificate book is lost.

This is an on-going project with more records being added all the time. This site provides digitized images of death certificates for 1917 - 1956. Six counties (Calhoun, Gilmer, Hardy, Harrison, Mineral and Pendleton) are included in the initial database for birth, death and marriage records and include all records microfilmed for those counties. Note that these records go as late as 1930; however, later additions to the data base will only include birth records that are past the 100-year mark and death records that pass the 50-year mark. As records pass these age limits, they will be added each year. Additional counties' records have been and will be added as the records are indexed. When you go to the search page for each record type, there is an information column that gives the county and the years for the records included.

The images are currently very large and require that you scroll up, down, right and left to view the entire image and they are working to make the images a more convenient size.

Accessing and Searching the West Virginia Vital Research Records

- Go to http://www.wvculture.org/vrr/va select.aspx
- Select the desired record type birth, death, or marriage and the Search window will open. For example, the Search window for the births is shown below.



- Fill in the search box(es) as desired.
 - ▶ Use * to search for zero or more characters before or after the search term.

Examples: Jef* returns Jeff, Jeffrey, Jefferson, etc. Ste*en returns Steven, Stephen, etc. *alton returns Dalton, Walton, etc. Using a * before and after a search term will find that term anywhere in the field.

- ▶ Use to replace a single character with a wildcard character.
 - Examples: J_n returns Jan, Jen, Jon, etc. _an returns Dan, Ian, Jan etc. Je_ returns Jeb, Jed, Jen, etc. Multiple may be used.
- Last names may include both maiden and married names
- Set the drop-down menus if you want to limit the search, change the number or records returned per page, etc.
- Click the Search button or press <enter>.

• The Search Results window will open. For example, see the Birth Search Results window shown below.
