What is the Wisconsin Historical Society Research Portal?

The Wisconsin Historical Research Portal is a collection of databases provided by the Wisconsin Historical Society. Included in the Research Portal are the following:

 - The Wisconsin Pre-1907 Birth Records Index includes approximately one million names from Wisconsin birth records dated between 1852 and September 30, 1907.
 - Pre-1907 marriage and death indexes are included in the index. There are over 2 million vital records in our index

- Enter the last name for which you are searching. You must enter at least three letters, so, to catch all variant spellings, you may use Wil to find all surnames beginning with Wil. This field is not case sensitive. Do NOT use apostrophes in such names as O'Malley. Spaces are not necessary
- The first name field is optional. You may enter a couple of letters to broaden your search. For instance, entering Ed with return all names beginning with Ed such as Edith, Edmund, Edward, etc.
- **County** field is optional. You may click on the **View a Map** option to see a county map of Wisconsin so that you may determine surrounding counties.
- Enter an **Event Date** and/or **Year** (4-digits) if desired.
- Click on Search or press Enter.
- The Search Results Window will open.

- If desired, use the search limiters of **Birth Only**, **Death Only**, **Marriage Only** or **WNI Only** at the top of the window to limit the results to just see those fitting that criteria selected..
- Click on the **Details** button for the entry you wish to view.
